

Richmond curbside recycling guidelines.

Do recycle in your green container.

Clean paper

Newspapers and inserts	Magazines and catalogs
White letter computer paper	Paper bags
Telephone books, paperbacks	Pizza boxes (clean, no food or grease residue)
Corrugated cardboard (flattened to 2'x2' max, no tape, no string)	Wrapping paper
Junk mail	Box board (cereal, cracker, shoe boxes, etc.)
White and colored office paper	Remove any plastic liners

Containers

All plastic bottles, jars and tubs
Aerosol cans
Juice, milk cartons
Clear plastic hinged containers (i.e. plastic berry containers)
Drink boxes
Glass bottles and jars (green, brown, clear)
Tin, steel, aluminum cans
Metal jar lids
Aluminum foil and trays

How to prepare

Empty: Make sure all containers have no material inside them.

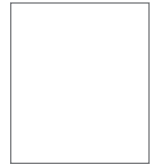
Clean: Rinse the containers well so there is no food or liquid residue inside and discard caps.

Dry: Make sure all of the containers are dry before putting them into the recycling container.

Do not recycle

Food-contaminated paper
Frozen food boxes
Crushed or broken glass
Clay or plastic flower pots
Anything bigger than 2.5 gallons
Ceramic, pottery
Light bulbs
Motor oil bottles
Polystyrene (styrofoam)

Plastic cutlery
Window, plate or auto glass
Drinking or eye glasses
Photographs
Paper plates, cups
Waxed paper, cardboard
Paint cans
Plastic bags
Plastic film, wrap
Loose plastic bottle caps



Place **recyclable materials only** in your green container and set it out at the curb according to the calendar on the reverse side.
All recyclables and waste must be out at the curb by 7:00 a.m. and in a manner acceptable for collection. Place waste in acceptable containers.

No plastic bags of any type (do not put recycling in trash or shopping bags)

Items prohibited at Richmond curbside collection

Appliances such as refrigerators, dishwashers, washers, dryers, and stoves

Construction/demo: sheetrock, tile, brick, concrete, etc.

Yard waste: leaves, brush, grass and hedge clippings, etc.

Miscellaneous items: TVs, computer monitors, lead-acid batteries, air conditioners and stumps.

Remember: Use your green container when you recycle!
